

Suggested Wording to Give Your Solicitor

Wording to include a Residuary and/or Pecuniary Legacy to Jewish Care in a new will or codicil to an existing will or codicil to an existing will

It is strongly recommended that you consult a solicitor when making or changing your will. He/she will ensure that the legacy clause is correctly included and that the will or codicil is properly executed.

Residuary legacy (all or a proportion of your residuary estate)

I give all or% of the residue of my real and personal estate which I can dispose of by my will in any manner I think proper, to Jewish Care (Registered Charity No. 802559) of Amélie House, Maurice and Vivienne Wohl Campus, 221 Golders Green Road, London NW11 9DQ and the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of Jewish Care shall be a complete discharge to my executors.

Pecuniary legacy (a set sum)

I give the sum of pounds to Jewish Care (Registered Charity No. 802559) of Amélie House, Maurice and Vivienne Wohl Campus, 221 Golders Green Road, London NW11 9DQ and the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of Jewish Care shall be a complete discharge to my executors.
